

BUILDING AND GROUNDS COMMITTEE

ANNUAL REPORT 2021

Our Building and Grounds Group responded to the following needs relevant to maintenance of the church's building and grounds:

- We did not have a typical Spring or Fall clean up this year due to COVID 19. We did however accomplish many of the normal duties by people just showing up to the church to do whatever was needed to be done. Bushes were trimmed and leaves were picked up.
- In the Spring our parking lot was patched, sealed and striped. We also added 5 new handicap accessible parking stalls by the main entrance.
- 7 trees were removed on the property. The Green Team is looking into planting new trees.
- A solar system was installed in November by Midwest Solar. Alliant should be giving us the green light to turn on the power soon.
- The outside lights were converted to LED in order to reduce our electrical usage. This work was done by Bee Line Electric.

For the coming year action is anticipated on the following:

- Spring cleanup in Late April / Early May (weather dependent). This will include trimming of shrubs and trees, cleaning out the supply shed, cleaning windows, putting down black dirt and seeding, landscaping around the church sign, removal of Christmas lights on pine tree, window repairs if needed.
- Staining of the concrete wall that was exposed when we took out the planters.
- Repair of the flashing around the skylight by a roofing company.
- Fall Cleanup in October/November (weather dependent).
