ANNUAL REPORT, 2020

Our Building and Grounds Group responded to the following needs relevant to maintenance of the church's building and grounds:

- We did not have a typical Spring or Fall clean up this year due to COVID 19. We did however accomplish many of the normal duties by people just showing up to the church to do whatever needed to be done. Bushes were trimmed and leaves were picked up.
- We hired a company to come in and make drywall repairs/paint in the fellowship hall and sanctuary.
- Shingles were coming off the steeple, so we hired someone to come in and make the needed repairs.
- Soap dispensers were replaced in the bathrooms.
- After reviewing our Capital Campaign fund balance, we determined that we had enough money to complete the removal of the large planters and have a patio poured. This was completed in October by Avant Landscaping and Casey Concrete.
- Colleen Krattiger and I took down the short retaining wall outside the sanctuary exit door and replaced with larger blocks that were being removed from the large planters.

For the coming year action is anticipated on the following:

- Review of the Capital Campaign fund balance to see if we will be able to complete parking lot sealing and striping and the addition of new handicap parking by steeple.
